A Survivor's Journey

"Me and my 5 year old had been stalked and harassed online by my ex-husband. It wasn't just online, he would show up everywhere. It was torture that seemed never-ending. We already had gotten one injunction for protection but it didn't last long enough. I filed again but was denied. I was so scared and discouraged.

The judge gave us an opportunity to bring additional evidence and state our need but I knew we couldn't do it alone. So I called Quigley House.

Their hotline advocates gave me a referral to their Injunction for Protection attorney and paralegal. They were incredibly understanding and kind. They got right to work helping me gather evidence for my court hearing. I just wanted all of this to be over and move forward, they helped support me and with their help the judge finally listened. The judge granted me a permanent injunction for myself and my daughter, and I can't begin to describe that feeling. **We were finally safe and protected.** I would not have been able to get through this process without the help and knowledge of the Quigley House team."

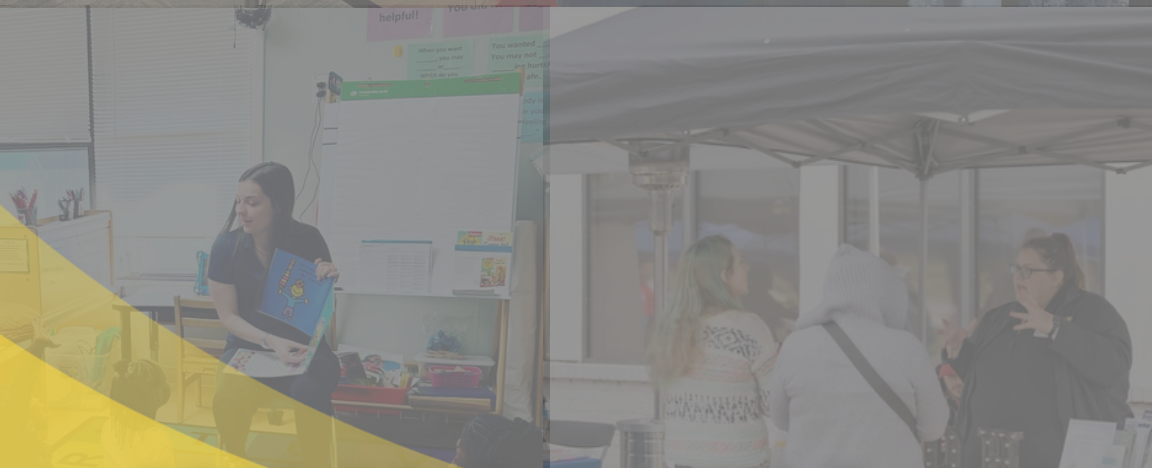
